





Artical l.

This organization shall be entitled THOR. It shall continue under all obligations contracted under its previous title : Turk's Head Organization of Rocketry , West Theater section of the NAR.

Artical 2.

It shall be the purpose of this section to ald and abet the aims and purposes of the MAR within the boundarys of Chester and Delaware counties, and surrounding areas of southeastern Pennsylvania. THOR shall, in all instances, operate model rockets in accord with the laws of the commonwealth of pennsylvania.

Artical 3.

ALL members of ther shall be members of the WAR in good standing residing in Chester or Delaware counties, or the surrounding areas of southeastern pennsylvaria. A person is a resident if he is regesterd to vote in said area, or in the case of a minor, his parent or guardian is regestered to vote in said area.

Artical 4.

Membership shall be divided into the following categories:

- I. Attending Mambers who currently line and/or work in areas as outlined in Artical 2. These members shall be subject to full payment of dues as and in artical 4.
- II. In Absentia Members who currently live and/or work elsewhere for the primary purpose of attending school military service, temperary residence overseas or summer job out of the area. Additional reasons are subject to judgement by the membership. Members is this category may be granted reduced dues as detarmined by and voted upon by the membership.

Artical 4-a.

Dues shall be six dollars annually, payable all at once or at fifty cents per month paid on or before the first meeting of the month. Section dues are distinct from dues paid to the MAR its afilliates or other organizations. The dues monies and other monies shall be kept in a general fund by the treasurer, and shall be paid out by him only after a majority consenting vote of a quorum of the membership as defined in artical 8.

Artical 5.

Meetings shall be held on the first and third Sundays of each month.

Meetings may be postponed or cancelled as deemed nessessry by the board of directors, as defined in artical 7. In addition special meetings may be called when deemed nessessry by the board of directors. Launches contests and/or lecture-demonstrations shall not be considered as a meeting.

Artical 6.

The officers of the section shall consist of a President, Vice-President, a Secretary and treasurer. Officers shall be elected annually for a one year term at the first meeting of the fiscal year beginning july 1. (continued)

In addition, there shall be the posts of Range Saftey Officer, Launch Control Officer, And editor of the newsletter. These may be filled by appointment by the president of the section. The newsletter editor shall serve for one year and may appoint any member or non-member to be assistant editor if deemed nesesary. These shall be considered as secondary offices one or more of which may be held by one person.

Artical 7.

The board of directors of the section shall consist of the four elected officials, an elected member at-large from the section and will conduct any board decisions and buisiness at hand at all meetings.

Artical 8.

For all busness conducted by the section, approval and ratification shall be conducted as follows:

Motions or nominations shall be from the floor upon recognition by the presiding officer. A quorum shall consist of at least three fourths of the membership of the section. A simple majority consenting vote shall constitute approval and ratification by the membership. A member of the section may be elected to only one primary office.

Artical 9.

These by-laws may be amended by a vote as defined in artical 8. Amendments ratified shall become valid upon approval by the NAR.

Artical 10.

Any member who is thought to have violated any NAR or section saftey regulations during the cource of any section activity shall be subject and Hyles to appropriate course of action by the board of directors. If this situation arises all board members must be present. The plainiff may y to got 1500 have anyone he wishes to act in his behalf. The following courses of action may be taken.

I. The board will take no further action.

II. The board will temporarily revoke all membership privleges for a length of time determined by the board. dues shall still be required.


III. The board will permanently revoke all privleges and the member in question will no longer be considered as a member of the section, Any dues monies owed by said person will become due immediatly.

All board decisions on the matter will be made by a four-fifths vote.

Artical 10-a

Any member permanenly disbanded may apply for readmission to the club by a 100% vote of the entire membership, If refused may not be permitted to re-apply.



Flashbulb cluster ignition:

Supplys needed:

- Sure shot ignitor wicks (Centuri)
- Flashbulbs from flashcube or AG-1 or AG-1B flashbulbs
- Some wire (thin phone wire or sim-
- Rocket engines!
- Masking tape

Fig 1 Side view . Fig 2 90° rotation .



Bend shure-shot as shown and insert into the engine. Put point of flashbulb into the nozzle and bend shurshot up around the side of the flashbulb, and tape in place. Then take a 1/3" wide piece of tape and secure bulb to base of engine as in figure 1. Repeat for other engines, put into rocket and wire them in perallel and voils instant reliable ignition!
